- Day 1**
Thursday
March 24:
NEWARK - FRANKFURT: Depart Newark Airport on your overnight flight to Frankfurt, Germany. Dinner served shortly after take off. Sit back, relax and enjoy the flight!
- Day 2**
Friday
March 25:
FRANKFURT - ROTHENBURG: Morning arrival into Frankfurt Airport, where we are met by our airport assistant, who will lead us to our awaiting bus for transfer to Rothenburg. We travel south to Rothenburg, part of the romantic road. Afternoon check-in. The remainder of the afternoon is free to relax or explore this charming town on our own. Tonight enjoy a welcome dinner with the group. Overnight in Rothenburg.
- Day 3**
Saturday
March 26:
ROTHENBURG: After breakfast at the hotel, enjoy a walking tour of Rothenburg, best-preserved medieval city in Europe. Inside those undamaged 13th-century city walls is a medieval town seemingly untouched by the passage of time. Dinner is on our own tonight. Overnight in Rothenburg.
- Day 4**
Sunday
March 27:
ROTHENBURG: After breakfast, the day is free to explore on our own. Overnight in Rothenburg.
OPTIONAL FULL DAY EXCURSION TO NEUSCHWANSTEIN CASTLE (Disney's Cinderella Castle): \$128 per person (based on 20). Enjoy a full day excursion where we have a guided walking tour, bus transportation, and entrance to Neuschwanstein Castle to see the castle that inspired Disney's Cinderella Castle. Neuschwanstein was King Ludwig II's fairy-tale castle. Construction lasted 17 years. Return to Rothenburg for overnight.
- Day 5**
Monday
March 28:
ROTHENBURG – REGENSBURG – ROTHENBURG: After breakfast, we embark on a full day excursion to Regensburg with English-speaking guide for approximately 2 hours. Regensburg is one of Germany's best preserved cities, relatively undamaged by World War II bombings. Catch a glimpse of the Danube River. We visit St. Peters Dom (*inside visit not allowed*). Enjoy the afternoon at leisure in Regensburg. Return to Rothenburg for overnight. Dinner is on our own.
- Day 6**
Tuesday
March 29:
ROTHENBURG: After breakfast, the day is free to explore on our own. Overnight in Rothenburg.
OPTIONAL FULL DAY EXCURSION TO MUNICH: \$111 per person (based on 20). Enjoy a full day excursion, half day tour with English-speaking guide (for approximately 3 hours) to Munich. Visits to Amalienburg, Nymphenburg Palace, and the Cathedral Frauenkirche. Lunch on our own. Return to Rothenburg for overnight.
- Day 7**
Wednesday
March 30:
ROTHENBURG – DINKELSBUHL – ROTHENBURG: After breakfast, depart on a full day excursion to Dinkelsbühl. Still surrounded by its medieval walls and towers, Dinkelsbühl is straight out of a Brothers Grimm story, even down to the gingerbread, one of the town's main products. There will be an English-speaking guide for approximately 2 hours. Afternoon free at leisure. Enjoy a farewell dinner together. Share the stories of our week's fun adventures. Overnight in Rothenburg.
- Day 8**
Thursday
March 31:
ROTHENBURG – FRANKFURT – USA: Early morning transfer to Frankfurt Airport for your return flight home, taking with you the memories of a wonderful week in the fairy tale land of Germany.

Departure taxes/fuel surcharges are subject to increase until February 22, 2011. Once tickets are issued, a name change fee of \$250 per ticket will result if names are spelled incorrectly (must be exactly as listed on passport). Air mileage is not allowed for group space. Seating assignments for group space are given by airline at check-in; there are no exceptions for this. **Deviations are not allowed. Cancellation – Land Penalty:** From initial deposit – November 24, 2010, a \$120 land penalty per person will apply. From November 25, 2010 – January 7, 2011, a \$270 per person land penalty applies. From January 8 – February 21 2011, a \$620 per person land penalty applies. On or after February 22, 2011, cancellations made after business hours, there is no refund. Cancellations must be made during Celtic Tours business hours, Monday – Friday, 9am to 5pm EST. Travel Insurance is available at \$119 p.p. and is recommended.
