Day 01
Monday,
March 15th **USA – Munich:** Depart the States on your AllItalia overnight flight to Munich. Dinner is served aboard, shortly after take off.

Day 02
Tuesday,
March 16th **Munich - Salzburg:** Early morning arrival into Munich Airport. Welcome to Bavaria. Meet our English-speaking assistance/guide and coach for a panoramic city tour in Munich. See the Bavarian Alps in the distance. Continue to Salzburg in the afternoon for check-in at your hotel, your home for the next 6 nights. A baroque city on the banks of the Salzach River, Salzburg is the beautiful capital of Land Salzburg. This former site of the Roman town of Juvavum is set against a pristine mountain backdrop. The city and the river were named after the early residents who earned their living in the region's salt mines. Long a part of the Holy Roman Empire, Land Salzburg was joined to Austria in 1816 following the Congress of Vienna. Enjoy a welcome dinner at our hotel with the group. Overnight in Salzburg.

Day 03
Wednesday,
March 17th **Salzburg:** This "heart of the heart of Europe" is the city of Mozart, who was born here in 1756. After breakfast we meet an English-speaking local guide for half day walking tour of Salzburg, including entrance fee to Mozart's Birthplace. *Tonight enjoy an **optional Mozart Concert Dinner** (\$98 per person – must be prebooked).* Overnight Hotel in Salzburg.

Day 04
Thursday,
March 18th **Salzburg:** After breakfast, the day is free to explore on our own. **Optional Sound of Music Tour (\$68 per person – must be prebooked):** *This excursion to the lake district and other places where the 1965 movie with Julie Andrews was filmed. The English-speaking guide shows you not only the highlights from the film, but also historical and architectural landmarks in Salzburg and parts of the Salzkammergut countryside.*

Day 05
Friday,
March 19th **Salzburg:** After breakfast, the day is free to explore on our own. We may choose to travel to Innsbruck (1½ hrs by train per direction, no train changes). The capital of Tyrol, Innsbruck is one of Europe's most beautiful cities and was host of the winter Olympics in 1964 and 1976. It has long been a center of commerce and traffic, as it lies at the junction of two important routes across the central Alps. Overnight in Salzburg.

Day 06
Saturday,
March 20th **Salzburg – Vienna – Salzburg:** After breakfast, we board our coach for an excursion to Vienna. Vienna is a city of music, cafes, waltzes, parks, pastries, and wine, a true cosmopolitan center, where different tribes and nationalities have, for centuries, fused their cultural identities to produce the intriguing and, often cynical, Viennese. Get acquainted with a half day guided tour. Free time in the afternoon to explore Vienna on our own. Return to Salzburg for overnight.

Day 07
Sunday,
March 21st **Salzburg:** After breakfast, the day is free to explore Salzburg on our own. We may wish to revisit Vienna (3 hrs by train, no train changes), or visit Munich (1½-2 hrs by train, no train changes) by train. Tonight enjoy a farewell dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Salzburg.

Day 08
Monday,
March 22nd **Salzburg – Munich:** After breakfast, we leave our hotel and travel to Munich for our return flight, arriving home the same day. We take with us wonderful memories from "the Heart of Europe."

**Note: Airfare in all-inclusive cost is based on airline tickets being purchased by December 1, 2009. No name changes are allowed once airline tickets are issued. Changes in your return date may affect your airfare. Tickets, once purchased are non-refundable with a minimum air penalty of \$762 per ticket. Once issued tickets cannot be re-issued if names are spelled incorrectly. Deviations are not allowed. Air mileage is not allowed for group space. Seat assignments are given at Check In for group space, there are no exceptions. Land cancellation: Initial deposit – 65 days prior to departure, penalty is: \$250 per person. From 64 – 1 day prior to departure, penalty is: \$600 per person. On or after day of departure there is no refund. Cancellations must be made during Celtic Tours business hours, Monday – Friday, 9am to 5pm EST. On or after day of departure or cancellations made after business hours, there is no refund. Travel Insurance is available and is recommended. Travel insurance must be purchased with initial reservation/deposit, and is non-refundable.
