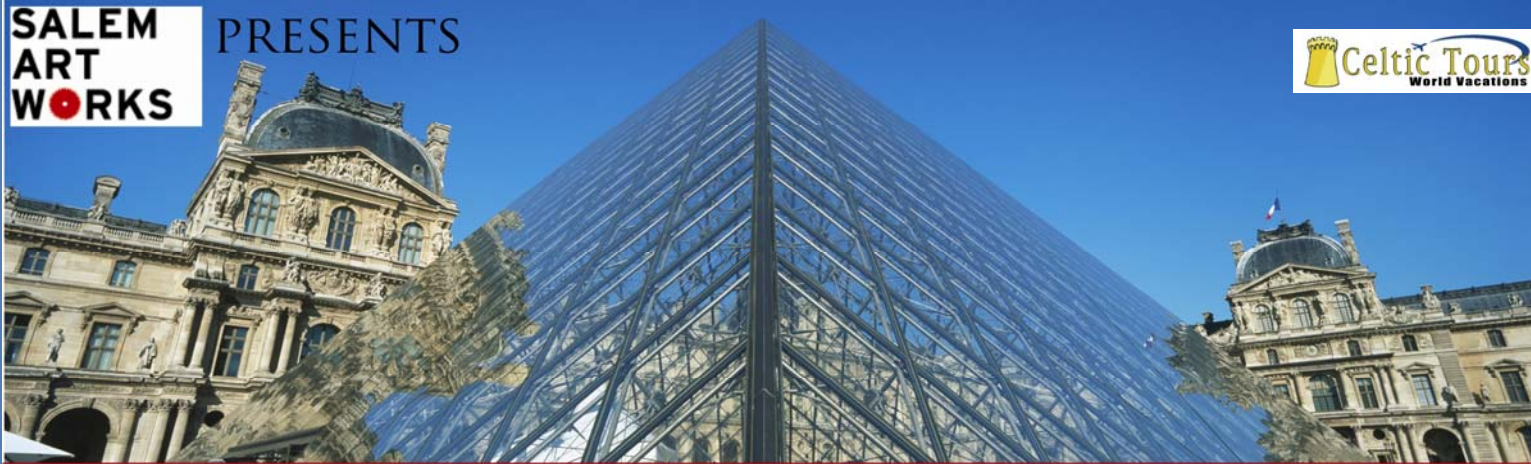

Day 01, Tues. Jan. 31st USA – Paris: Depart JFK on your overnight flight to Paris with Aer Lingus. Dinner is served aboard, shortly after take off.

Day 02, Wed. Feb. 1st Paris: You will be greeted by a Celtic Tours representative, who will direct you to your awaiting motor-coach for transfer to your Paris hotel, your home for the next 6 nights. The Métro is an easy, fast, and cost-effective way to see Paris. After check-in in the afternoon, the remainder of the day is free to rest or explore Paris on your own. Dinner is on your own.

Day 03, Thurs. Feb. 2nd Paris: Free day in Paris. Get acquainted with this city, known for such classic sights as the *Eiffel Tower*, *Musée du Louvre*, *Notre-Dame*, the *Arc de Triomphe*, *Sacré-Coeur*, and all those atmospheric cafes. Don't forget the parks, and squares, the Champs-Élysées and other grand boulevards, or even the river Seine and its quays. Dinner is on your own.

Day 04, Fri. Feb. 3rd Paris: Free day in Paris. Dinner is on your own. You may wish to visit *Sainte-Chapelle*, a tiny chapel, called a jewel box by many writers. On a bright day, the 15 stained-glass windows seem to glow with Chartres blue and with reds that have inspired the saying "wine the color of Sainte-Chapelle's windows."
OPTIONAL Versailles: You may wish to join an option ½ day excursion to Versailles (\$99 p.p. additional, where you visit the Ver-

sailles Palace, which has out dazzled every other kingly residence in Europe, a symbol of a regime obsessed with prestige.

Day 05, Sat. Feb. 4th Paris: Free day in Paris. You won't want to miss the *Musée Rodin*, acclaimed as the father of modern sculpture, the single best-known work, *The Thinker*. Dinner is on your own. Tonight you may wish to go out in style and treat yourself to the *Moulin Rouge* dinner show (*must arrange on your own*) with its renowned show girls at the home of the French cancan.

Day 06, Sun. Feb. 5th Paris: Free day in Paris. Museums in Paris are free on the first Sunday of the month. Ask your concierge what hidden delights Paris has to offer or chose a day enjoying the art collection at *Musée de l'Orangerie*, *Musée d'Orsay*, *The Picasso Museum* is in a huge 17th century mansion, tucked away on a little backstreet in the 3rd arrondissement. Some say this museum is one of the best (*and least-crowded!*) museums in Paris. Dinner is on your own.

Day 07, Mon. Feb. 6th Paris: Free day in Paris. Dinner is on your own. Today visit one of the spots still on your list, or revisit a favorite before you leave.

Day 08, Tues. Feb. 7th Departure: After breakfast, with the help of an English-speaking assistant, depart for nearby Charles de Gaulle International Airport for check in for our flight back home.



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*Note: **Airfare** in all-inclusive cost is based on airline tickets being purchased by September 20, 2011. Air departure taxes and fuel surcharge subject to increase until 30 days prior to departure, even if paid in full. **No name changes are allowed once airline tickets are issued.** Changes in your return date may affect your airfare. Tickets, once purchased are non-refundable with a minimum air penalty of \$843 per ticket. **Once issued tickets cannot be re-issued if names are spelled incorrectly. Deviations are not allowed. Air mileage is not allowed for group space. Seat assignments are given at Check In for group space, there are no exceptions. Land cancellation:** From initial deposit – 119 days prior to departure, penalty is \$50 per person. From 120 – 65 days prior to departure, penalty is: \$200 per person. From 64 – 31 days prior to departure, penalty is: \$550 per person. Within 30 days of departure, there is no refund. Cancellations must be made during Celtic Tours business hours, Monday – Friday, 9am to 5pm EST. On or after day of departure or cancellations made after business hours, there is no refund. Travel Insurance is available and is recommended. **Travel insurance must be purchased with initial reservation/deposit, and is non-refundable.** Celtic Tours & the Salem Art Works accept no responsibility for losses or expenses due to delay or changes in schedule, flight cancellations due to mechanical problems, sickness, weather, strikes, war, quarantine or other causes.
